### • Plan Ahead for Your Dog's Overnight Stay

We are not a typical "boarding kennel" but we do provide overnight boarding. Current clients need to check for availability to schedule. Just Dogs has limited kennel space and limited weekend boarding.

## New Dogs

New clients must bring their dog for at least one day of day care before we can schedule overnight boarding. We have your dog come prior to boarding to allow them to become acclimated to us, the kennel, and the other dogs. This makes their future overnight stay less stressful.

## • Proof of Vaccinations

We require proof from your veterinarian that your dog is current on their <u>Rabies, DHLPP and Bordetella</u> vaccines. We require a Bordetella vaccine yearly but some veterinarians **recommend one every six months**.

## • Payment for Your Dog's Overnight Stay

Payment is due in full when you pick up your dog. We accept cash and personal checks only.

Overnight stay is \$30 per dog, for day and night, for up to 24 hours. If your dog is here longer than a 24-hour period, you will be charged additional as follows: \$14 for 5 hours or less or \$22 for more than 5 hours per dog. There is no discount for multiple dogs.

Special Needs We can accommodate for most special needs, such as, administering simple medications and providing enhanced meal preparations. You may be charged an additional
\$5 to \$10 per day, per our discretion, depending on your requirements. We need to know if your dog has any special medical or feeding needs before scheduling your dog's stay. Please bring us written instructions for these requirements.

# • Drop-Off and Pick-Up Times

Monday through Friday drop off or pick up time is <u>during day care drop off and pick up times</u>. Saturday and Sunday drop off or pick up time is <u>by appointment only</u>. There is someone at Just Dogs throughout the day on weekends however, the actual time they are here can vary each day. Please make arrangements for pick up time prior to leaving your dog.

# • Food, Bedding and Toys

Please, <u>bring your dog's own food</u>. It does not have to be pre-measured, just let us know how much to feed your dog. We feed twice a day, unless otherwise instructed. Fresh water is available with meals and throughout the day. We provide bedding and toys that are appropriate for your dog. You are welcome to bring a few from home, however they may get dirty, damaged, or shared.

• Flat Collar and Leash

Your dog must have on a secure, **<u>quick-release buckle collar</u>**. Tags are not necessary and often fall off. Your dog's leash must be 6' long or shorter; sorry, no retractable leashes. Please label or customize your dog's leash, so we know which one belongs to your dog. For your dog's safety and the safety of the other dogs, **you must have your dog on a leash from your car to the gate or door**.

• Other people picking up your dog

If someone other than you will be picking up your dog, please include those names on your dog's registration form in our records and make arrangements for pick-up prior to leaving your dog. For your dog's safety, <u>we will not release them to anyone that is not pre-approved</u> by you to pick up your dog.
